

Covid-19

For further detailed guidance please refer to the Melbourn Playgroup and Out of School Club Covid-19 risk assessment which can be found on our website. The Covid-19 risk assessment for the setting will continue to be regularly reviewed and will contain current guidance.

The setting will continue to implement protective measures; good ventilation, enhanced cleaning protocols and additional hand washing.

Children and staff travelling abroad will be advised to follow the current government guidance.

Any forms such as accident forms and existing injury forms will be done by email.

Any child or member of staff displaying any Covid-19 symptoms will not be allowed to attend the setting and will be advised to take a PCR test. Current government guidance must be followed before they are able to return.

Food will not be provided by the setting.

Safety procedures for visitors and parents into the setting will be outlined in the risk assessment.

The necessity for wearing masks and when will be outlined in our risk assessment in line with current guidance and cases in the area.

We will implement our outbreak management plan if necessary if the number of cases within 10 days, among children or staff who have mixed closely:

- Increases rapidly or
- 5 cases or
- 10% of the cohort or
- Single hospitalisation or death due to Covid-19
