

Nappy changing

Changing areas are warm and cannot be viewed from outside.

Two adults are to be in the room at all times when nappies are changed.

A record is kept of all intimate care carried out.

Each child has their own bag from home which should contain their nappies or 'pull ups' and wipes.

All staff follow the correct hygiene procedures when changing nappies, wearing gloves and disposable aprons.

Staff are gentle when changing; they avoid pulling faces and making negative comment about 'nappy contents'.

Nappies, trainer pants and ordinary pants that have been wet or soiled are bagged for the parent to take home.

Barrier cream is treated as any other medicine.

Nappy changing space is cleaned with anti-bacterial spray in between each child.

Children must not be left unattended on the nappy changing table.
